The Order of Engineers of Angola (OEA), in collaboration with UNESCO, FAEO, and WFEO is organizing the 10th UNESCO Africa Engineering Week and the 8th Africa Engineering Conference, which will take place in Luanda, the capital of the Republic of Angola, between 9th and 13th September 2024.

- AIM

The event will focus on engineering aims to educate the youth and the general public about the engineering profession, through strategic outreach activities such as educational workshops, public awareness events, mentoring activities and university events. The aim of the event is to show how engineers are key players in the solutions to important continental challenges, such the provision of clean drinking water, sustainable housing, and issues around climate change.

Africa, together with the rest of the world, is faced with a shortage of engineers. This is a major concern, particularly as there has been declining interest in the profession from the youth, with the enrolment of young people, especially women in the profession dwindling.

Engineering is vital to addressing basic human needs, improving the quality of life, and creating opportunities for sustainable prosperity on a local, regional, and national level. The continent faces a situation where there are a lot of older more experienced engineers, but not enough young candidate engineers entering the profession. Our ability to sustain the profession lies heavily in the number of young people choosing engineering as a career.



- **Objectives**

1. To increase the visibility of engineering and its role in sustainable development;
2. To encourage students to study engineering by supplementing STEM curriculum with practical engineering applications;
3. To incite more African countries to participate ensuring the sustainability of these efforts.

The activities during Africa Engineering Week will increase the visibility of engineering, which is particularly important in the continent where there is a great need for engineers to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
